### EXAMINATION PROCEDURE FOR PUPILS DURING MID-YEAR & END OF YEAR EXAMS

- Pupils are to sit in alphabetical order.
- A see-through plastic sleeve is to be used as a pencil bag.
- Only materials necessary for that examination will be allowed into the examination venue.
- All bags are to be left outside the venue.
- No borrowing of equipment will be allowed.
- Pupils may not do other learning or work or reading when finished.
- NO cell 'phones will be allowed into the examination hall.

(School rules apply) Pupils will receive 0% for the exam if caught with a phone on their person.

- No walking around during the examination.
- No talking or any other form of communication will be permitted.
- Pupils requiring assistance are to raise their hand and wait quietly for the invigilator to come to their table.
- Pupils are not allowed to leave the exam venue during the exam.
- All rules pertaining to behaviour, dress and appearance will be in force.
- Pupils are to remain silent and seated until all answer sheets have been collected by the invigilators.
- No eating or drinking will be allowed.
- Pupils are to set out their answer sheet correctly:
  - Pupils must write on both sides of their paper.
  - They must write clearly and legibly.
  - They must number their answers clearly and correctly.
- Pupils must report to the exam venue **5 minutes** before the commencement.
- Absenteeism requires a medical certificate otherwise 0 is given for the exam.
- If any irregularities arise, the Head of the College will be informed immediately and parents will be contacted.
